The different colors and textures, plus its natural cleft surface, make this product very unique. In recent years there have been some new manufactured textured surfaces introduced into the market. These include: Thermal faced, bush-hammered, and honed. Samples are available upon request.

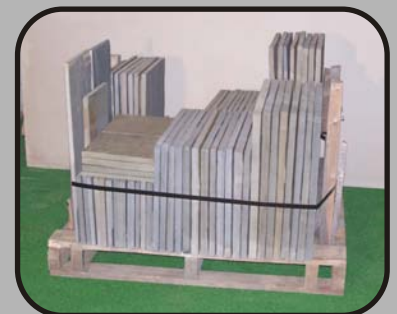
